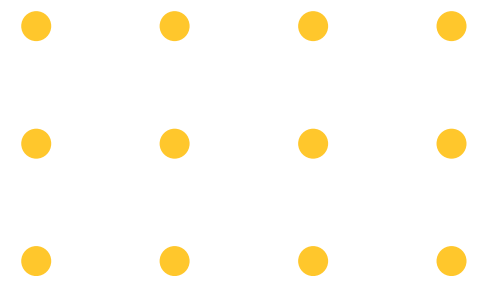
METHODOLOGY OF LDA - WAR/POSTWAR AND COHESION INSTRUMENTS

Local Democracy Agencies are registered NGOs, with a multistakeholder support and a focus on good local governance, with a host Municipality/region and partners in the EU, coordinated by ALDA. We have 17 LDAs so far, with hundreds of partners.

Multi stakeholder approach with local authorities and civil society

- LDA Mostar : Region of Puglia, City of Vejle, city of Mostar, civil society from Puglia, Vejle and Mostar, engaged in democracy support, peace building and local economic development.

Long term partnership/friendship

- LDA Zavidovici, Paweł Adamowicz prize, born on a tragic event (death of 3 volunteers) has now more than 25 years of activities between Bosnia Herzegovina and Italy (Cremona, Roncadelle), exchanges of youth, programmes for rehabilitation of refugees.

Flexibility and reactivity

- LDA Dnipro and LDA Mariupol, the partnership of Lower Silesia Region and the City of Gdansk have accompanied the LDAs throughout these years, with flexible approach and partnership.

City diplomacy and solidarity

- LDA Central and Southern Serbia, supporting first good local governance programme (first European flag in Nis, Southern Serbia) - still operations, accompanying EU Enlargement.

NGOs and local authorities supportive

- ALDA's support : advocacy work, coordination of actions, fundraising, coordination and strategic approach.
